Julia specializes in out-of-body experiences, spiritually transformative experiences, non-ordinary transcendent experiences, as well as exceptional human experiences.

She is the co-author of a 432 Hz music-based sound therapy CD.

Born in Banovce nad Bebravou, in Western Slovakia (former Czechoslovakia), Julia experienced her first out-of-body experience in 1995. Since then, she has devoted all of her time to the study of out-of-body experiences.

She is a former translator-interpreter, a lecturer in the Russian language, and an English teacher at the first private school in the Slovak Republic focused on the behavioral problems of children with learning disabilities and emotional problems. Executive Manager and head of the international section of the presidential election campaign (Slovakia), she is the foreign relations adviser to the ex-Prime Minister of the Slovak Republic, an analyst for the Department of International Relations, deputy manager of the central election campaign, a foreign correspondent accredited to the US Department of State, and a freelance writer and lobbyist. She also worked for the Fund for Constitutional Government based in Capitol Hill, Washington, D.C.
